HOW TO LEAD SWORD DRILLS

Looking up verses in the Bible

"the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God"

Eph 6.17

- 1. "Draw Swords!"
 - Raise your Bibles, hands on the spine of the Bible
- 2. Give the address of the verse [Kids repeat the verse]
- 3. "Charge!" Kids hurry to find the verse in their Bibles
- 4. THIS PART IS IMPORTANT
 - *As each one finds the verse
 - *she/he stands up and
 - *reads the first word aloud.
 - *teacher waits until more than half have found the verse and are standing.
 - * then the first one who found it to read the verse aloud s.l.o.w.l.y.
 - *Those who have not memorized the books of the Bible
 - may put their fingers in the table of contents at the command to "Draw Swords!"
 - so they can look up the page numbers
 - or may put their fingers at Matthew 1
 - *With a large span between oldest and youngest, divide the verses up into groups.
 - give the first verse to the younger group and the next verse to the older kids.
 - on some verses give the verse only to those who need to use the table of contents

- give some verses to everybody

Change it up and ask them to shout out the theme of the next several verses: salvation, miracles, holy living, Rapture, etc.
