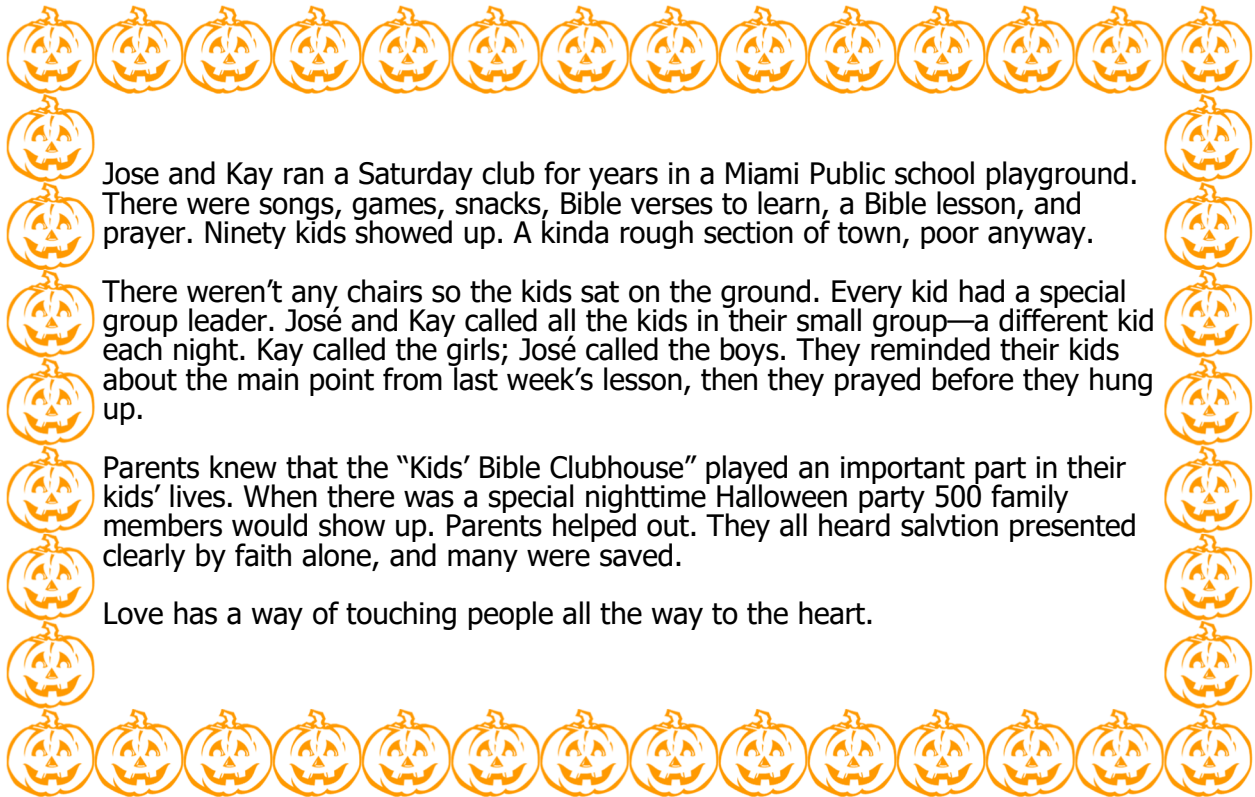


90 KIDS IN A PLAYGROUND BIBLE CLUB
