

HOW I USE THE HEAVEN TEST

Have you ever had trouble getting a spiritual conversation started ?

I have. So I almost always carry 3 tracts with Bible verses in my wallet.

Here are 5 sentences I've used to make it easy to give someone a tract.

- Have you ever taken a Heaven Test?
- Have you ever taken a Heaven Test with Bible verses in it?
- Would you do me a favor? [*pause—hand him/her the tract*]. There's a Heaven Test inside you might like to take. It uses Bible verses to explain how to get to get to heaven.
- In a crowd when I'm handing out dozens or hundreds of these tracts I just ask, "Hey! Did you get your Heaven Test, yet?" [*Nobody ever says, "Yes."*]
- I've known you for a long time, but I don't think I ever gave you one of these, did I? Somebody took the time to tell me how I could be sure of going to heaven. This little booklet has a bunch of verses that explain that nobody's good enough to earn his salvation. I know I'm not.
- Here, stick this in your pocket and read it when you get home. I'll ask you whether you passed the Heaven Test when I see you tomorrow [or next week, or in study hall, or ...].

Many times I've loaned someone a pencil so he could check off the boxes he thought were the best. I've even told people, "Nope! You flunked the Heaven Test." [*I always smile nicely!*] So far, no one has really gotten mad.]

*Use the nicest paper you can afford.
Try to avoid using copy paper.*

At the Staples store

- ◆ RESUME paper - 100% cotton
24 lb \$17 for 100 sheets [makes 200 tracts]
32 lb \$15
- ◆ LINEN paper 25% cotton
24 lb \$14
- ◆ ANTIQUE LAID 25% cotton
24 lb \$16 [ivory]
- ◆ GRANITE 25% cotton
24 lb \$16
