We could not refer to any information from any other verse.

We walked into class the next period "pumped."

We were all pleased but amazed by what we had discovered with our magnifying glasses and shovels as we pored over those 39 words.

Acts 1.8

All we know it that is in the Bible somewhere.

- 15. 4 geographical areas
 - * nearby to far away
 - * 1 city, 2 counties, one global
 - * Judea & Samaria border one another
 - these counties were not friendly to each other
 - * 2 have brief descriptions: <u>all</u> Judea / <u>uttermost part</u> of earth "part" (not parts)
- 16. global statement, earth = ges, $\gamma \varepsilon \sigma$ = we get "geo" [geo-graphy]
 - * not same Word as "world" [John 3.16] kosmos κοσμος
