Introduction

- 1. Timothy was pastor in Ephesus, one of the most significant cities in far western Turkey. [1.3]
- Themes in the book: sound teaching, false doctrine, elders, widows
- 3. Paul & Tim had visited Ephesus on Paul's second church planting missionary tour.
- 4. They had stayed for 3 years [during 3rd miss. tour] then Paul put Tim in charge when he left town, [1.3].
- 5. Ephesus had the largest idol temple in the world at the time: Diana (*Latin*), Artemis (*Greek*), already 500 years old * larger than 2 US football fields [field = 45,000 sq ft] temple = 93,500 sq ft]
- 6. Scene of riot [commotion] when P & T visited the first time.

Timothy already had a great reputation in 2 cities, Lystra & Iconium [Acts 16.2]. Maybe mid 20s? pjm Surely was saved long before he met Paul a year an a half prior [II Tim 3.15, from a child. . .salvation] After being stung by Mark on their first trip [Acts 13.13], Paul certainly wouldn't have taken on a baby Christian for this trip.

- 1.3 jumps right into major theme = sound **doctrine**, teach 20X
 - * eight flavors of false teaching: 1.3 4.1-3 6.3-5: apostasy, doctrines of demons, fables, vain janglings, slander, genealogies, evil spirits, guarrel about words
 - * defend the faith! I Tim 1.18

I Tim 1.3 don't flinch at preaching the truth I Tim 4.1 expose, oppose

I Tim 1.10 sound doctrine

bad doctrine: Hym. & Alex, I Tim 1.20 Hym. & Philet, II Tim 2.17,18

- 1.6 <u>swerved...turned aside</u>
- 1.7 false teachers, "teach" and "doctrine" in I Tim a major theme = 12x
- 1.9,10 14 sins
- 1.11,12 Tim entrusted same as Paul was, I Cor 4.2 Col 4.17 Phil Myers was entrusted the same way.
- 1.13,14 Paul's memory scalds his soul often, grace applied
- 1.15 to save sinner, Paul was the worst sinner he knew. I, Phil, can say the say the same thing about myself. You, too?
- 1.17 7-point adoration
- 1.18,19 challenge to Tim: keep the faith, danger of shipwreck I Cor 9.27 = castaway, disqualified Paul mentions lots of shipwrecks in his epistles.
- 1.20 examples of shipwrecked lives, [I have initials of only 5 shipwrecked friends in my Bible]
- 2.1 4-point primer on prayer, each point one is a whole sermon
