

Praying to Receive Christ? Huh?, Why the sinner's prayer does not save.

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* If you believe Jesus died for your sin in your place—you are saved. If you pray, just thank Him.

If you didn't do anything except believe—you are saved.

If you were trusting in your good life to save you before you said those magic words, you are still lost in your sin.

Praying may help you remember that Jesus saved you but the act of praying is nowhere found in the Bible. The closest wording says "confession is made unto salvation." That just means you told somebody. Rom 10.10 The mute cannot confess with the mouth. It's unnecessary.

* "Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Rom 10.13

I was 5 yrs old. My dad led me to the Lord and never told me to call on Jesus.

- 10.15 how shall they hear without a preacher: email, internet, TV, radio, postcard, Gideon Bible
- 10.17 *faith comes through hearing*, a figure of speech. Most people believe after they hear the Gospel. Everyone already
 - has placed his/her faith in something: religion, false teaching, philosophy, friend's opinion, mom's
 - agnosticism, idolatry, misreading of the Scripture, persuasive speaker, good works.

Now they change the object of their faith from good works an place it solely in Jesus Christ.

- * Nothing important about the faith. Object of faith is supremely important.
- * Don't let anybody convince you that God grants a special faith *[or grace]* to certain people. There are no clear verses in the Bible that say that.

hearing by the Word of God, if they don't hear what the Bible says-they cannot be saved. Nobody just "thinks" his

way to God as Thomas a Kempis taught. God cannot save anyone through a dream or flash of light if he has never heard words from the Bible [yes, maybe paraphrased].

- 11.1,2 <u>cast away His</u> [foreknown] people?, no, God hasn't forsaken them, but most Jews remain unsaved. As an ethnic entity they have been chosen. But that doesn't mean they believe in Jesus.
- 11.12-24 11X if, what situation does each if refer to?
- 11.24 <u>*re-grafting*</u> is rather unusual

11.25 *blindness in part*, every living Jew has at least heard that some people believe Jesus is the Messiah.

- * Jews have a tremendous head start in coming to faith.
- * see the 6 perks every Jew has , notes at 9.4
- 11.27 *take away their sins*, a strange little figure of speech meaning:
 - * Jesus took the punishment for my sin(s)
 - * removed my transgressions as far as east is from west, Psa 103.12, infinitely
 - * Isa 38.17 God "remembers no more" means "just as if I'd never sinned"
- 11.33 *how unsearchable*, patience, Phil, you'll have a billion years to study it.
- Chapt 12 over 30 exhortations to live holy lives

12.1,2 <u>transformed</u>, meta+morph = to change form, see also, II Cor 3.18 Only long term commitment leads to spiritual maturity.

12.3 <u>not too think more highly</u> of yourself, Phil. Phil 2.3 "esteem others"

after the 2 lists in I Cor there is a whole chapter on how to use your spiritual gifts with LOVE.

- 12.9 *abhor that which is evil*, work at it, Phil. I Pet 3.11
- 12.13 <u>hospitality</u> = not entertaining or parties. It is just opening your home to strangers, neighbors, dll. hospitality, philoxenian φιλοξενιαν = love strangers, aliens, visitors
- 12.16 *not haughty*, watch out, Phil Myers. You've been confronted with this one.
- 12.17 **no man evil for evil**, I Thes 5.15 "but seek after that which is good"
- 12.19 *revenge not*, but sometimes it feels sooo good. Don't get back or get even.

- 13.1,2 *whoever resisteth the power* [his own government], It seems this would include England, 1776.

* The Church was not sent to straighten out flawed governments.

- * For 300 years not one Christian writer ever supported any military. Why?

 15.24 <u>Spain</u> = 3,000 miles probably on foot <u>and to be helped on my way there</u> [to Spain], KJV "to be brought on my way thitherward by you" * This part of the letter is the "fund raising" part. Yes, it is okay for those who "live of the Gospel" to expect churches to support them financially. But this was the most explicit comment in 2,342 verses he wrote.

16.5,14,15 = 3 churches Paul had visited in the area around Rome: aquila & priscilla's house church S+A+P+H+P+H and the brethren with them P+J+N+S+O and all the saints with them

16.7 <u>Mark them which cause divisions</u>, this is no fun Only 3 reasons for excommunication:

- Heresy
- Immorality
- Divisiveness
