\* highest vitamin K, for clotting developed in late  
1900s
7. Psa 102. 25,26 entropy [*everything is winding down*] 1650  
\* Newton's 2nd Law of Thermodynamics Newton, UK
8. Psa 8.8 the waters (seas) go round in circuits, paths 1850  
\* example, B. Franklin, Gulf Stream, 1700 M. Maury, USA

12. Gen 1.11-13 "everything after its own kind"
