DAVID'S 10 CONSEQUENCES FOR HIS ADULTERY & MURDER

Ten punishments [5 different means]: sword, evil, reproach, wives, & child

"Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife."

2 Sam 12:10

God does not think lightly of His best servants' public sins. God is fed up! Full forgiveness, yet consequences, too.

- II Samuel 12.18 child dies

 II Samuel 13.14 Tamar defiled

 II Samuel 13.29 Absalom <u>murdered</u> Amnon

 II Samuel 16.22 Absalom sleeps with David's concubines to spite Dad

 II Samuel 17.25 Absalom usurps David's throne

 II Samuel 18.14 Absalom <u>murdered</u>

 II Kings 1.15 Adonijah usurps Solomon's throne

 II Kings 2.24,25 Adonijah [Solomon's brother] <u>murdered</u> by Solomon, his brother

 II Kings 17.23 Ahithophel led revolt then <u>hanged</u> self
- There are almost no recorded consequences to Saul's decades-long hatred toward David, but God enacts enormous consequences upon David's family for his one-night-stand with Bathsheba.
- Psa 51 & 32 both Psalms contain deep, gut wrenching sorrow for David's sin.
 Sorrow does not always remove negative consequences.
