Hebrews 2.18, **“He is able to succor”** [help, assist]

## How was Jesus tempted?

- Tempted by Satan: pride, hunger, worship, Matt 4.1ff
- Human fear of the pain of the Cross, Matt 26.36ff
- When slandered, He retorted not, John 8.4
- When mocked, He defended not, Mark 15.1,30 Isa 53.7
- When accused, no revenge, Matt 26.57ff
- When rejected, He sulked not, Matt 26.57ff
- Spit on, Matt 26.67
- Beaten, Matt 27.26
- Stripped, Matt 27.27,28
- And then He took my sin and paid for it, Heb 12.2  
\* *How have we been tempted like He was?*

## other human emotions

- ◇ Jesus wept at Lazarus’ tomb, John 11.35
- ◇ Cried over Jerusalem, Luke 23.37
- ◇ Sobbed in Gethsemane, Heb 5.7
- ◇ Joy
- ◇ Care for children, sick, unbelievers
- ◇ Kindness
- ◇ Forgiveness
- ◇ He was: hungry, tired, sociable, in favor with God and man.
